Magnetic Plug Weld Tool Review

I have purchased several of the Vim # MPWT, Magnetic Weld Plug Tools. They work extremely well. I have used them for many types of repairs. I run a custom metal fabrication company that builds one-of-a-kind vehicles to restoring parts for 40-50 year old pedal cars and tractors. I also do a lot of metal panel repair work on older vehicles and antique farm machinery and tractors. These work very well with the 16 gauge and lighter sheet metal that I am working with. They also work very well when welding expanded and perforated metal sheeting. Many of these parts must be restored since they cannot be purchased due to their age. They work well for filling holes in sheet metal, body panels, truck and tractor frames. The welds can be ground down and painted to look like new. With the magnetic base, it no longer requires two people to handle the job.

I am anxious to try your new tool #MPWT2X and #MPWT2L with the larger pad size in the future. Having different size round pads from 1" to 2" would be beneficial as well to help draw the heat from a larger area.
